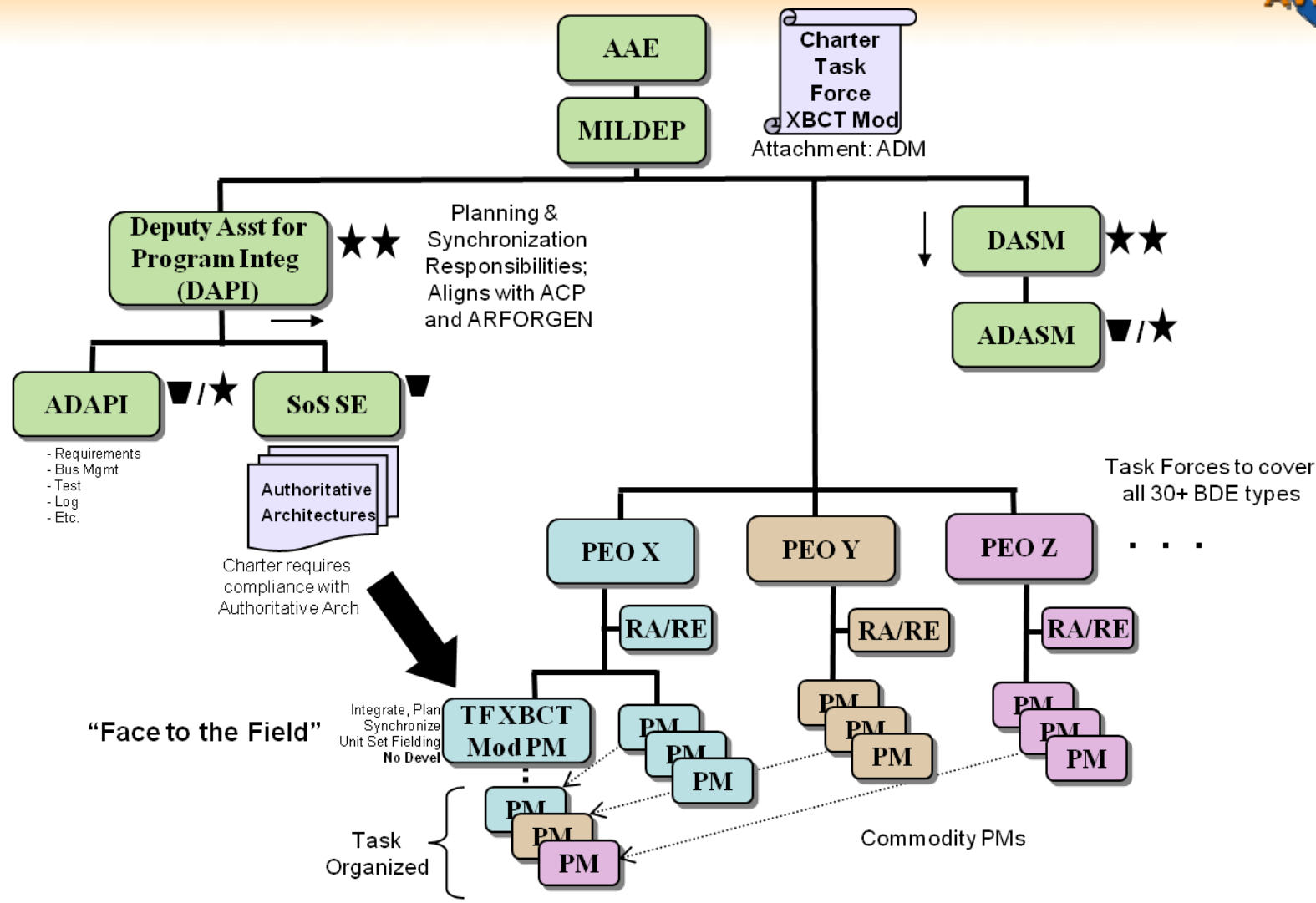

Proposed ASA(ALT) Management Structure

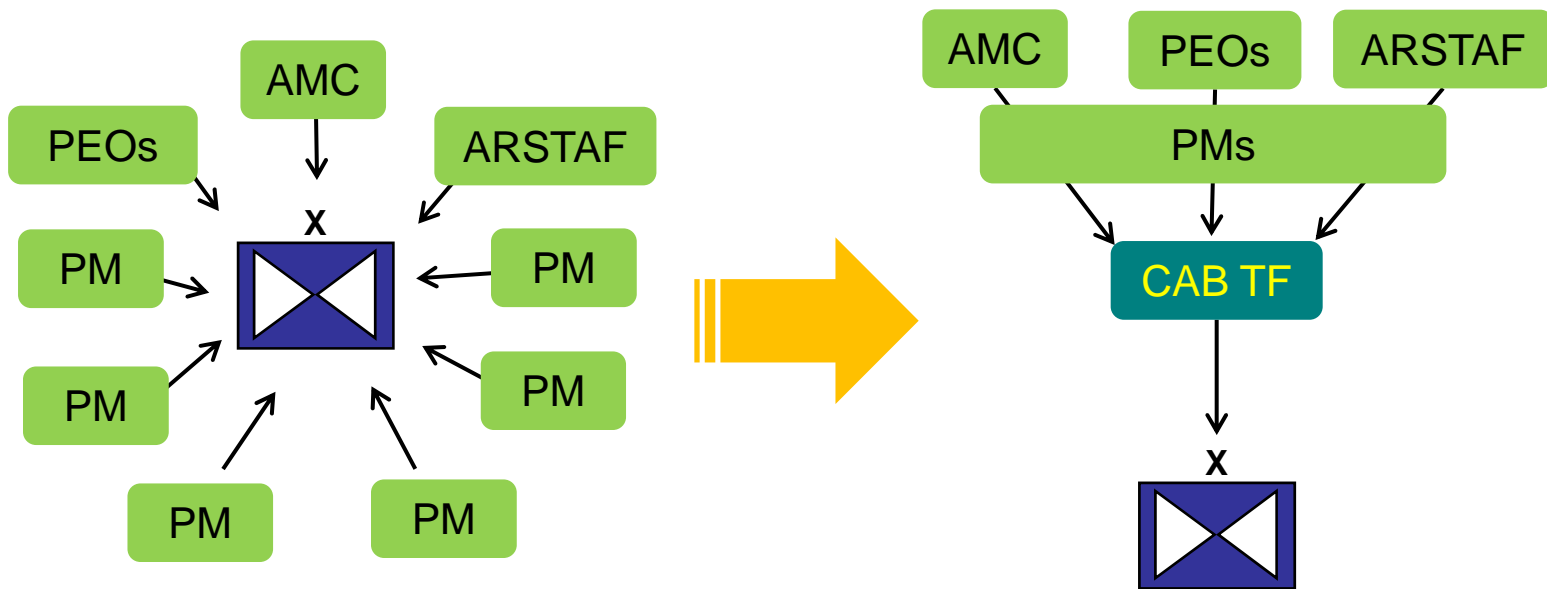


Aligns with Operational Army Construct - Organized to Deliver Integrated, Affordable, Relevant BDEs IAW ACP & ARFORGEN

Challenge



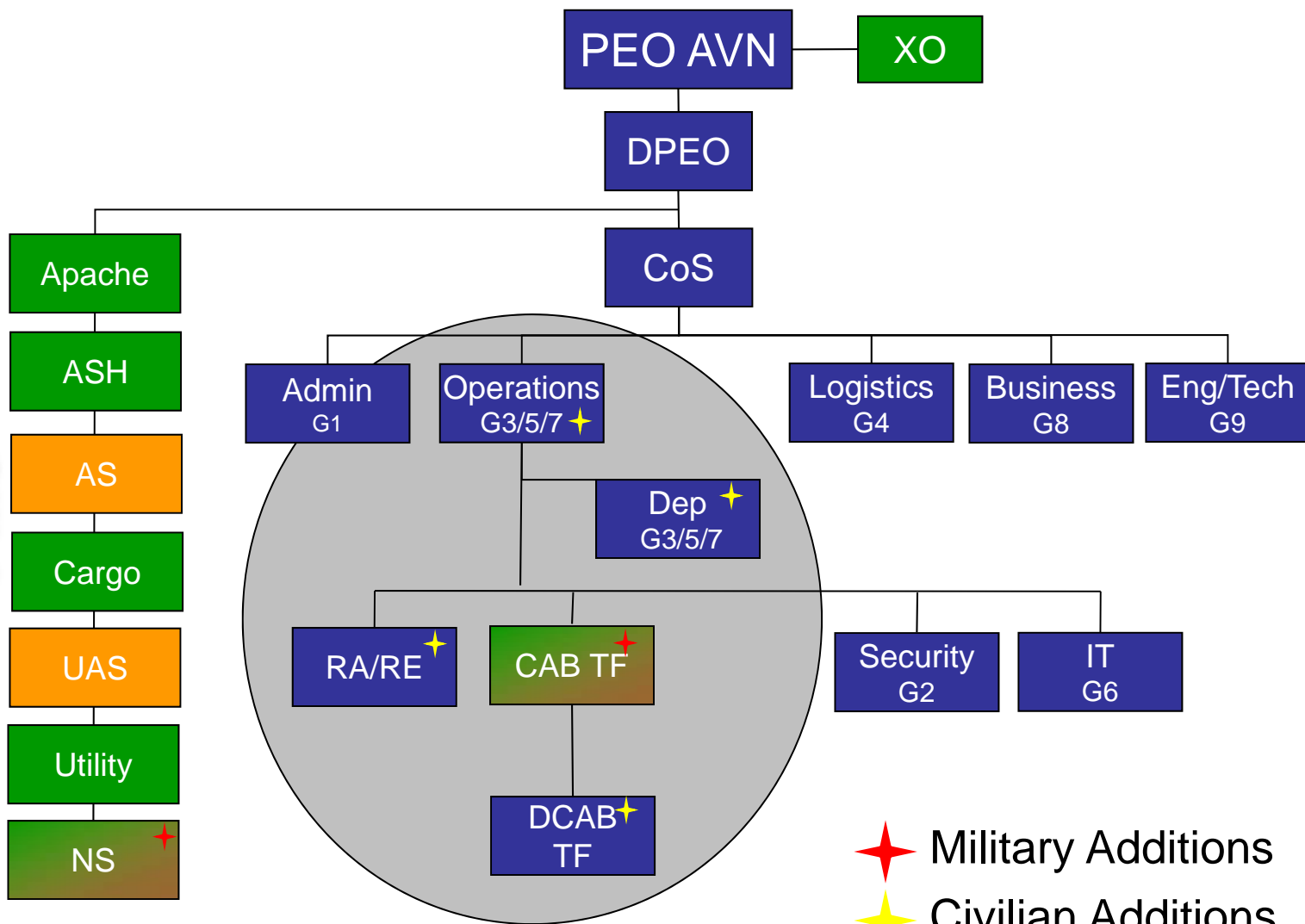
- Shift in Interaction with CABs for Acquisition/Fielding from Many-on-One to One-on-One.

- Concept Plan Reinforces AMC and ASA(ALT) Materiel Enterprise Methodology
- ARFORGEN Model will Continue to Prioritize Reset Units and Schedule
- AMC Organizations, in Coordination with PEO/PM, will Continue to Execute Sustainment and Reset Missions in Support of Materiel within CABs
- CAB TF will be Authorized Direct Liaison with ARSTAFF (G1, G3, G4, G8), AMC, and Army Commands
- PEO AVN will not Receive Budget Authority for other POR Systems
